Dear Parents and Carers

15 November 2020

I am writing to inform you that we have received confirmation that a year 11 student within our school community has tested positive for COVID-19 and your child has been identified as a close contact of the person concerned. We are going to review this fully tomorrow (Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November) and if there are any changes to the recommendations from the Local Authority and Public Health England, we will inform you immediately.

The Local Authority advise that year 11 students who have been in close contact should self-isolate until Thursday 26th November 11.59pm. Therefore, your son/daughter's first day back in school will be Friday 27th November. We look forward to welcoming your child back to school on this date. This is a period of 14 days from when they last had contact with the person affected. If your child in year 11 has any brothers or sisters in another year group at our school or any other school/college, they can still go to school unless they or someone in your household develops symptoms.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- **a high temperature** this means they may feel hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to take their temperature with a thermometer)
- **a new, continuous cough** this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if they usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste this means they may tell you that they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different.

Should your child, or other household members start to develop symptoms of COVID-19 please arrange to get them tested.

You can get a test at a testing site, or by asking for a home testing kit.

I can assure you that our school is very careful to make sure everyone follows Government, Local Authority and Public Health guidance for cleaning, hygiene and social distancing.

In the event of your child or a member of your household developing symptoms or testing positive please inform the school immediately.

Our school is still open to all other children unless previously notified of the need to self-isolate.
