Dear Parents and Carers

28th November 2020

Sorry to be communicating again so soon but I am writing to inform you that we have received confirmation that another student within our school community, who has **not** been identified as a close contact of your child, has tested positive for COVID-19. Your child **should continue to** self isolate as per my last letter of communication until Monday 7th December 2020. This does affect other students in Y9 but **not** your son/daughter.

Following Government, Local Authority and Public Health guidance the affected person and their family have now started their isolation.

We have sent a letter to parents and carers of children, of the school group directly affected telling them that they need to isolate until the 9th December 2020 and are due back into school on 10th December from when they last had contact with the person affected.

I would like to reassure you that our school is very careful to make sure everyone follows Government, Local Authority and Public Health guidance for cleaning, hygiene and social distancing.

Should any member of your household start to develop symptoms of COVID-19 please arrange to get them tested and inform the school immediately.

The main symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- **a high temperature** – this means they may feel hot to touch on their chest or back (you do not need to take their temperature with a thermometer)
- **a new, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if they usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **a loss or change to their sense of smell or taste** – this means they may tell you that they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different.

Should your child, or other household members start to develop symptoms of COVID-19 please arrange to get them tested and please inform the school immediately.

If your son/daughter receives a positive test result please inform the school immediately. If it is outside school opening hours, please use the following email address to inform us: covid@cottinghamhigh.net

You can get a test at a testing site, or by asking for a home testing kit.

I can assure you that our school is very careful to make sure everyone follows Government, Local Authority and Public Health guidance for cleaning, hygiene and social distancing.

Our school is still open to all other children unless previously notified of the need to self-isolate.

Please can we ask you to remind your child(ren) of the relevant government guidance, which should be adhered to during the isolation period:

You must not leave your home if you're self-isolating.

- *do not go to work, school or public places – work from home if you can*
- *do not go on public transport or use taxis*
- *do not go out to get food and medicine – order it online or by phone, or ask someone to bring it to your home*
- *do not have visitors in your home, including friends and family – except for people providing essential care*
- *do not go out to exercise – exercise at home or in your garden, if you have one*
