Dear Parent/Carer

LFD testing

Public Health England are asking that your child continues to test twice a week over the summer using the LFD tests. Any positive cases should be followed up with a PCR test.

We have been asked to conduct two Lateral Flow Device tests with all students in September, which will mean that the start of the term will be slightly different. The date and timing for your child to have their first test is **Wednesday 8th September**:

Y9 (this is Y9 in September, who are currently Y8)

Students will line up in their form group at the back of the old block gym. Staff will be in attendance to direct and inform them of what they need to do. We will have a specialist team of trained staff who will administer the LFD test. As soon as the test has been conducted, students will need to leave the school site and go home until the 9th September. If your child tests **positive**, we will inform you.

Your child's second test will take place on **Monday the 13th September** during lesson time.

All students will be back in school on the 9th September.
