












Appendix 1: Cottingham High School Uniform

	<p>School Logo Blazer</p>		<p>Tie: KS3: red tie KS4: black tie</p>
	<p>Shirt: Plain white, long or short sleeved, formal uniform type of standard length to tuck in and with standard shirt type collar.</p>		<p>Optional Uniform: Plain black V-necked jumper, with or without school logo.</p> <p>Plain Black Belt. With small plain buckle</p>
	<p>Black Pencil or Box Pleat Skirt (worn with black tights at least 60 denier or black socks). Skirts must sit no more than just above the knee. They must not be of jersey material.</p>		<p>Footwear: Plain, black, black laces, polishable leather or leather-look shoes or ankle boots with flat or low heels. Shoes with logos in contrasting colours are not permitted. No other type of shoe (e.g., fabric, sandals) .</p>
	<p>Trousers Smart, tailored, plain black, formal uniform type. No Lycra, jean, cotton, or cord type material (worn with black socks).</p>	<p>Watches and jewellery</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A wristwatch with a plain strap • One single pair of small stud earrings in the lobe of the ear 	

Prohibited Items
Extreme hairstyles: including unnatural colours like blue, green, pink, purple, bright red, and patterns such as tramlines cut into the hair.
Make-up: Must be discreet including subtle foundation of the appropriate skin tone.
Other Piercings: Not allowed.
Nail Polish: Not allowed
False or Acrylic Nails: Not allowed
False Eyelashes: Not allowed
Leggings: Not allowed (only in PE)
Hoodies: Not allowed (Team members may buy hoodies and jumpers with the school logo, but they can't be worn as part of the school uniform).
Jewellery: A pair of simple studs can be worn. Learners are advised not to bring any other jewellery to school.
Smart Watches: Not allowed

Personal Possessions
Mobile devices: Using mobile devices is prohibited on the school grounds (on site out of sight). These devices must be switched off and kept in bags, out of sight on school grounds. They must not be in trouser or blazer pockets. Audio equipment or speakers are also not allowed. If a learner brings a mobile device or headphones or audio player to school, it is at their own risk. The school will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to these items. If the items are seen, they will be confiscated in line with the behaviour policy.
Money / Wristwatches / Jewellery: Learners are responsible for any small amounts of money or wristwatches or jewellery they bring to school.
